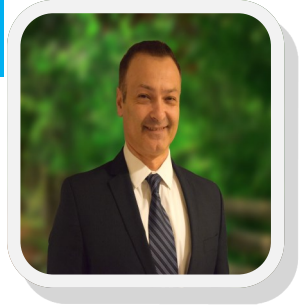

Dear Residents and Business Owners:

Spring is here and it's time to complete Spring Cleaning! We need you to do your part. Be a good and responsible neighbor. Please maintain your property by making sure the following items are maintained; the exterior of your home, look for cracked or peeling paint, repair or replace broken or missing windows and screens, maintain gutters and down spots, soffits, eaves and siding. Repair broken or missing fencing and gates, remove all damaged front yard fences, repair damaged garage doors and windows and keep your property clean from paper, junk and debris.

Cut your grass weekly to its proper length, grass clippings must be cleaned off sidewalks after every cutting. Pull weeds to keep weed growth under control around your home, add mulch to mulch beds. Flowers and plants are always an added attraction. The alley side of your property needs to be maintained regularly as well and it's the homeowner's or business owner's responsibility.

Trash cannot exceed what your containers can hold. Garbage cannot be put out until Wednesday. Recycling must go in the recycling container. The neighborhood belongs to all of us. If you see trash in the parkway – please pick it up.

All vehicles must have a current vehicle sticker including old cars that may not be used.

Maintaining your property helps keep the community clean and safe from animals and rodents. It helps to keep unwanted visitors from gaining access to your property. We want to see our residents take pride in their homes and our community.
